

DOWNLOADING EBOOKS ON YOUR KINDLE FIRE: THE BASICS

- 1) Start by connecting to a wireless network (NOT 3G):
 - Tap the Settings icon (looks like a gear in the upper right).
 - Select Wi-Fi.
 - Ensure Wireless Network switch is on.
 - Choose your network and select "Connect". The library's network is called "Guest" or "Guest1".
- 2) Tap "Web" and go to <https://e-inc.overdrive.com/>. You can do this by typing in the URL, or by clicking on "Download eBooks" from the library's home page.
- 3) Sign in to your account: Choose Chatham County Public Library, then sign in using the barcode on your library card (no spaces). Your pin is the last 4 digits of this number. After signing in, you'll be directed to the main e-iNC page where you can search or browse for eBooks.
- 4) When you find a book you'd like to download, click "Borrow" under the title's cover image and information. **MAKE SURE TO SELECT THE KINDLE BOOK FORMAT.** Once you download a book, you can't change formats.
- 5) You'll be taken to the Amazon website to complete the process. Click on the "Get Library Book" button. Sign in to Amazon using your email and Amazon password. Choose your device and click "Continue". You do NOT need to click the "Download Now" button. Your book should be delivered wirelessly to your device.

TROUBLESHOOTING: If you didn't get your book, try one of the following solutions:

- Connect using wireless, not 3G (usually solves the problem).
- Resync your Kindle.
- Check your archived items.
