

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Chatham County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Monday, December 3, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in the Auditorium of the Chatham County Agriculture Building, 15 South Street, Pittsboro, North Carolina. The hearing will address the permanent closing of a portion of a certain street in Moncure pursuant to N.C.G.S. Section 153A-241.

The portion of the street proposed to be closed is as follows:

All of Holmes Street west of its intersection with Jones Street (SR 1932), and being a strip or parcel of land approximately 60' by 210' located between the lands of the Gerald B. Fiks and Oma J. Crutchfield, Petitioners herein. Said portion of Holmes Street is more particularly described on the plat entitled "Map of Moncure and Vicinity" recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 1, and the plat entitled "Survey for Valent Lasater Dellinger Whatley Estate" recorded in Plat Slide 2005-353, Chatham County Registry, reference to which is hereby made for a more particular description.

All persons interested are encouraged to attend and express their views.
