



Construction & Demolition (C&D) Recycling Ordinance

The Chatham County C&D Recycling Ordinance was developed with the intent to minimize the amount of C&D debris being disposed of in landfills and encourage more recycling. C&D debris means building materials and solid waste from C&D sites. The ordinance applies to **any C&D site with a project that is 1,000 square feet or greater, located in the unincorporated areas of Chatham County**. C&D projects include construction, remodel, demolition, or any other related activity requiring a building or demolition permit. *(Exempted projects: Demolition due to fire damage; Installation of a pre-fabricated structure; Installation of a swimming pool.)*

Keep Your Disposal Records – It’s the Law!

Building or demolition permit holders are required to obtain and keep **ALL** disposal records for up to one year after project completion. Disposal records means receipts, weight tickets or other documentation from facilities accepting mixed or source-separated C&D debris, and includes the project address or building permit number, type of material, weight of material, date of disposal, facility name, and facility location. You may need to work with your hauler to obtain these records. These records may be subject to inspection by Chatham’s Environmental Enforcement Officer as proof of your compliance with the ordinance.

C&D Debris Disposal Requirements

For all projects subject to the ordinance, the permit applicant must fill in a C&D Debris Management section on the building or demolition permit application. This section asks if you will mix your C&D debris, or source-separate it, or a combination of both.

If you **source-separate** debris into separate containers, the separated debris must be hauled to any facility that will reuse or recycle it. Disposal of source-separated debris can cost considerably less than disposal of mixed debris. In addition to the facilities listed below, the county website also lists some local destinations that can accept certain separated materials for reuse or recycling. You will not need to list the facility on your permit application in this case, nor does the facility need to be licensed by Chatham County, but you will need to obtain and keep disposal records from any facility that accepts your separated C&D debris.

If you mix any C&D debris together, the debris must be hauled to one of the C&D facilities licensed by Chatham County listed below. These licensed facilities meet the ordinance’s required minimum annual recycling rate of 30%. In this case, you must list the licensed facility name on your permit application, as well as obtain and keep disposal records from the licensed facility.
